PASTOR'S CORNER

On behalf of the people of Haiti I wish to thank you for your great generosity in our collection last weekend. We were able to raise over \$4500. There is still great need in Haiti and equally there is great need in our own parish.

This weekend we officially introduce our new parish outreach program that will take the place of our St. Vincent de Paul Society. The new program is called “Help and Hope Outreach” and is designed to assist the members of our parish who are in need. As always we are looking for volunteers and any type of assistance you can provide.

Some ways are: 1) Use of the “poor box” in the back of the church. Your financial help will provide food, electric, gas and other necessities.

2) If you shop at Acme bring in the cookware stamps, you would be amazed at the number of people who don’t have pots and pans.

3) Make a casserole for our shut-ins and those in need.

4) Make booties, scarves and hats for the most vulnerable: our babies.

5) Just volunteer, we’ll find a job for you.

The saga of Wildwood Catholic is still ongoing. Some of our parishioners have decided to put their collection into “escrow” in order to pressure the parish to force the Diocese to keep the school open. The truth is that Wildwood Catholic is a parish school and no other parish or pastor has anything to say about its staying open or closed. It is totally supported by St. Ann’s parish (now Notre Dame de La Mer) and they have the first and final say about its future. Not even the Bishop has the power to shut or keep it open, he can only make recommendations. As a parish we will continue to pray for the future of Catholic Education and for more Catholics to re-involve themselves in practicing their faith. This is the only thing that will keep our Catholic School system intact.

Easter is early this year. Lent is right around the corner. As usual we will have a full schedule of events to help us celebrate these great seasons of repentance and rejoicing. Please check the bulletin for details and keep your Wednesday evenings free.

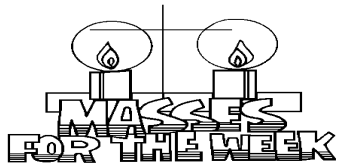
