Happy Valentine's Day: A Short History of St. Valentine

The Early Medieval [acta](#) of Saint Valentine were written by Bede and briefly expounded in [Legenda Aurea](#). According to that version, St Valentine was persecuted as a Christian and interrogated by [Roman Emperor Claudius II](#) in person. Valentine was a priest who refused to obey a law attributed to [Roman Emperor Claudius II](#), allegedly ordering that young men remain single. The Emperor supposedly did this to grow his army, believing that married men did not make for good soldiers. Valentine secretly performed marriage ceremonies for young men. When Claudius found out about this, he had Valentine arrested and thrown in jail. On the evening before he was to be executed Claudius met with Valentine. Claudius was impressed by Valentine and had a discussion with him, attempting to get him to convert to Roman paganism in order to save his life. Valentine refused and tried to convert Claudius to Christianity instead. Because of this, he was executed. Before his execution, he is reported to have performed a miracle by healing the blind daughter of his jailer. Valentine wrote the first "valentine" himself, addressed to the young girl. It was a note that read "From your Valentine" and encouraged the young girl to remain strong in her Christian faith and live the beatitudes. The same Beatitudes we hear today in Scripture.

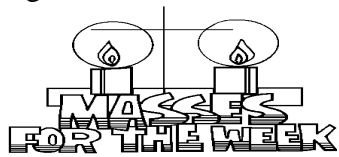
