REFORM YOUR LIVES! TURN AWAY FROM YOUR SIN AND BELIEVE IN THE GOSPEL!!

These words, spoken on Ash Wednesday, remind us of the seriousness of Jesus' message, a message sealed in His innocent blood. Today it seems that our most precious commodity is time and yet the message of Scripture is clear: "Make time for God and God will make sure that you have time for everything else." Our parish is providing a myriad of opportunities to develop our spiritual life this Lenten Season. Many have been on a starvation diet when it comes to being spiritually fed but Lent is truly a time of "calorieless" feasting.

Every Wednesday during Lent, following the Peace Mass we will journey with our Lord with our "Ashes to Easter Program" On Friday we have our free "fish dinner" hosted by the Knights of Columbus followed by Stations of the Cross. Each morning we celebrate the Eucharist and the chapel is open all day for adoration. Please read the bulletin for events and times of other Lenten activities.

On Ash Wednesday, when you received your ashes, you proclaimed: "Yes, I am a sinner, I acknowledge this before all the world and I publicly attest I am willing to do whatever is necessary change my bad habits into "habits of goodness." Jesus reminds us that these "habits" become sacred when we fast, give alms and pray. During the Lenten Season I remind you to use these gifts by giving a monetary value to that which you fast from and put the money in your Rice Bowl so that other's may eat. 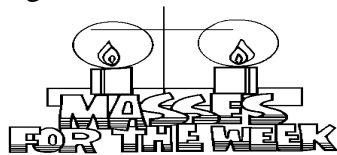
