PASTOR'S CORNER

Please note: Due to a lack of support for the St. Patrick's Day Party it has been cancelled.

In the aftermath of recent hurricanes and earthquakes and abnormal weather patterns some have dared to suggest that some areas are hard-hit because of the amoral lifestyle of some many of their citizens. This weekend Jesus is quick to dispel this kind of thinking. Like the deaths in the gospel this week, Jesus says that these deaths should not be attributed to sin. Rather, these incidents should serve as somber reminders that death comes to us all. He challenged the people of His time and all time to accept the truth that repentance and reformation are the only means of truly living the fullness of life here and accepting the gift of everlasting life.

The parable of the fig tree includes a detail that will make sense of any gardener. If a tree or plant is not productive, it may benefit from having its roots stirred up and a little manure applied. In the same way, if we have stopped producing and growing morally, we may need to examine our root motives, untangle our lives from dead habits and bad influences. Lent is a time to stir up roots. And even our past failures contain valuable insights and motivation for personal growth. Repentance acknowledges past failures and learns from them. This means that virtue that flows from the experience of forgiven and repented is stronger than virtue that flows from simple innocence. In other words those who have not failed have not tried.

What sometimes gets lost in the story is that the "fig tree" symbolized the leadership of the people of Israel. Jesus was also saying that they were going to be given one last chance to accept His leadership and embrace His messiahship. If not, they would soon be destroyed because of their lack of faith and because they refused to be obedient to the Law of Moses. We all know the result: Jesus was crucified and forty years later, Israel, Jerusalem and the temple were destroyed.

Jesus, in the form of the sacramental Church, became the new Jerusalem, not built by human hands and destined to endure forever. Lent is our time to reflect on our own journey and embrace the newness that Jesus offers. This Lent journey is best experienced in our Ashes to Easter program which follows the Peace Mass on Wednesday evenings.

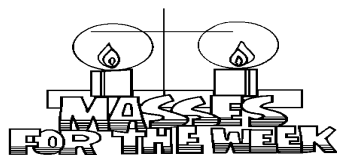
