PASTOR'S CORNER

As Our Lady of the Angels Catholic Community we rejoice with our 53 First Communicants and their families as we celebrate their continuing faith journey this weekend. It is a wonderful sign on this Good Shepherd Sunday of Jesus making the impossible the possible. He challenged the people of his day and our day to “eat his body and drink his blood” and then made it possible in the gift of the Eucharist.

During the week I shared at daily Mass a question that was raised during my seminary days: How long does the “real physical presence” of Jesus stay with us after we receive the Eucharist? According to those who know the answer is three minutes and 16 seconds. I don’t think this is any coincidence when we read Jn 3:16 and understand the mission of Jesus. After that very short time **we** are spiritually changed into the body of blood of Christ and given the mission to announce to all the world the “good news”.

As a parish we pray for these children to continue to grow in their faith and we pray for their families that they will often join us “at the table of plenty”. As always their preparation is a community event and I am grateful to Mary Joan, our parish staff and the many catechists and support teams who have worked so hard to make this day such a blessing. Next weekend at the 5 o’clock mass on Saturday and the 11 o’clock Mass on Sunday we will celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation. Again, as a community, we look forward to helping 38 of our youngsters begin to embrace their role as active, supportive and responsible members of the Catholic Church. Please remember them in your prayers this week and pray that they will be open to this greatest of all gifts: the Gift of the Holy Spirit.

Mark your calendars: The May Procession will be held after the 11 o’clock Mass on May 9th. It’s a great way to celebrate Mother’s Day and honor our Blessed Mother and our Patroness.

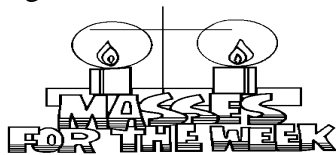
