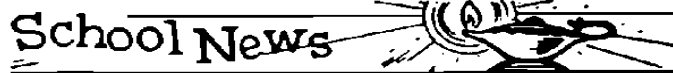

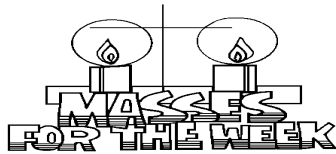
Respect Life
