PASTOR'S CORNER

Since the celebration of the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday evening, we have witnessed new members being initiated into our parish community through Baptism, reception of Eucharist for the first time and Confirmation. With that, all of us have been a part of Church in the truest sense of the word. What is Church? Church is us – the living members of the Body of Christ who live a new way of life through Jesus – relationship with a loving God whose love encompasses us completely. As followers of Jesus, we are called to be different in every aspect of our daily lives. Thank you for all of your generous contributions to the poor box and to our support of Holy Redeemer food bank.

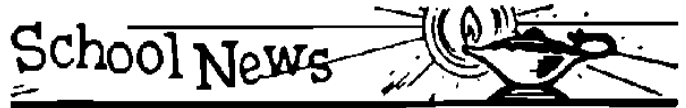

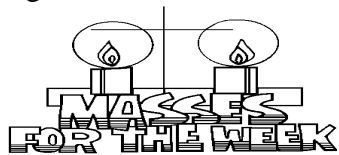
