## PASTOR'S CORNER

*In the reading from Acts of the Apostles, we see that St. Stephen is conformed to Jesus and it's true that the Holy Spirit will give the words to a Christian who needs to give an answer (an apologia) for what he or she believes. We don't have a lot of information about Stephen, and what we do know comes from the Acts of the Apostles. He is able to speak persuasively to the Sanhedrin, trusting that the Holy Spirit will help him to do this. He is very much in love with Jesus Christ. The relationship that he has with Jesus is one of personal experience of Jesus in the Word of God, his personal prayer, his prayer within the community that he belonged to and his experience of Jesus in the Eucharist. It's all very real for Stephen. He has been greatly affected by the relationship with Jesus and wants to share what he has experienced with others. We can look at Stephen and say, 'That's great for St. Stephen, but that is not me.' There is a story about St. Francis running through the streets of Assisi, knocking on doors, in tears, saying "Love is not being Loved." He meant that God, who is Love, is not being loved by his children. Francis was also affected greatly by Jesus and wanted so much for people to know him. Gifts of deeper faith, deeper belief in Jesus' presence in the Eucharist, stronger love for neighbor or the dispelling of fear in our life are gifts that God wants us to have. God will give them if we ask. Our Father in heaven knows how we are 'wired' and wants us to believe in God, experience God, tell about God and be free of fear because of God. God is not stingy with his gifts. We, on our part, only need to ask for them with our hearts. God always wants to give us things that are going to make us more mature in our faith, free us from fear and more easily love like God loves.*

Thank you for all of your generous contributions to the poor box and to our support of Holy Redeemer food bank.

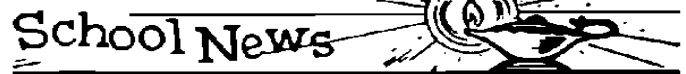
All donations to the poor box are used to support our families in the parish who may be in need of our help.

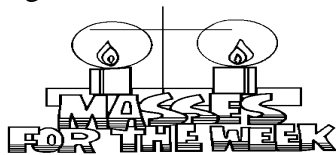
