# PASTOR'S CORNER

This weekend we celebrate another of those wondrously impossible promises fulfilled by Jesus. On this Feast of the Holy Trinity Jesus offers us a “theophany”, a direct encounter with God. Theophany is an encounter that redefines the future of a person or a community. It deals with experiences that are always elusive and always live beyond any human ability to describe them. In this gift, given when Jesus says: “My peace be with you”, there is an invitation to shalom, an integration and sharing in the balanced relationship of love that exists between Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

Jesus made this theophanic relationship only available through His Church which is experienced in the gift of the sacraments. These “encounters with God” teach us how to be encompassed by the Trinity, thus learning to live in love. Therefore our greatest energies should be directed toward reverence, respect, responsible action, reconciliation and rejoicing. In these we mirror the relationship of “shalom” which was Jesus’ gift to us so that we could experience the fullness of the Holy Spirit and see God – face to face.

One of the great tragedies of today is that so many people, many of our own parishioners included, think that they can control God or live without His “Shalom”, look around and you will see the fearsome and fearful results. You are here today because you have said “yes” to this theophanic relationship. Invite a friend to celebrate with us next week, be a witness of love and enjoy your God.

This year the monies collected from the second collection will be used to begin replacing the rugs in the Church. We will begin with the Sacristy and Chapel. Youth Group

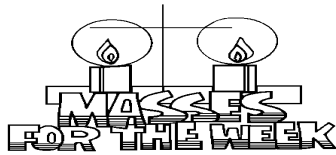
