PASTOR'S CORNER

This weekend we celebrate the Feast of Corpus Christi, the Body and Blood of Christ. It is the last of the great celebrations of the year and the fulfillment of all the improbable promises that Jesus made possible. Jesus promised He would rise from the dead – in the gift of the Resurrection, He did. Jesus promised that He would send us the Spirit as the greatest gift who would teach us all things; in the gift of Pentecost, He did. Jesus promised that He would ascend into heaven to prepare a physical place for us; in the gift of the Ascension, He did. Jesus promised that he would die on the cross for us for the forgiveness of our sins; in the gift of the Crucifixion, He did. Jesus promised that He would make it possible to become one with the Father and the Spirit as He was; in the gift of the Trinity, He did. Jesus promised us that unless we eat His Body and drink His Blood, we could never enter eternal life; He made it possible in the Gift of the Eucharist. HE DID IT ALL FOR US!!!! Why do we still doubt His agape love for us?

Today, Jesus multiplied the bread and fish and all were satisfied. His message stands in stark contrast to the “world’s message” that says we must constantly have more. In response, He gives us His truth that the “world” can never satisfy the real hunger that we have. This real hunger is union with the Triune God, Theophany, Shalom, the total satisfaction that is the result of being stewards of the Gifts of God. We stand with the Apostles and hear Jesus say, “Give them some food yourselves.” Do we despair or believe that He will make it possible?

I choose to believe!!! Like the disciples, we have the power to look over Jesus’ shoulder to see what He saw. God’s Son came to earth so that you and I can see and touch and smell and hear and taste our earth the same way God does. He did and rejoiced! Can’t you feel it? Just stop, be thankful and invite someone to share in the Eucharist, the great gift of salvific love.

Remember: We are now in the midst of our House of Charity Campaign – no one is exempt. Your sacrificial gift is vital. “Give them some food yourselves” was no idle command!!!

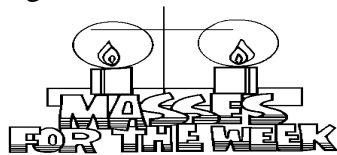
