PASTOR'S CORNER

The theme of this weekend's readings is "Forgiveness." From a scriptural perspective, forgiveness means to give love before it is asked for, earned or anticipated. This of course is not possible without being "righteous", that is, being in right relationship with our God who gives us the "peace" to die to self and thus be able to share 'agape' (unconditional love with others). This does not mean to stay in an abusive relationship. It means that we are to be obedient to the promptings of the Spirit, accept the gift of meekness which enables us to see ourselves as God sees us and then to act as Jesus would. This is not something that happens overnight but it is a decision we have to make many times a day.

Throughout scripture and relying heavily on our own Catholic tradition we know that we cannot enter into Heaven until we have made atonement for our sins and forgiven those who have sinned against us. This again is not something we can do unless we experience the unconditional love of Jesus. This is why it is so important to pray for those who have died. Our prayers help those in purgatory to acknowledge their sins and their effects, look into the eyes of Jesus and experience His redeeming love and feel the paralyzing effects of sin being removed from us.

Jesus tells us that we don't have to wait until we die for this to happen. He reminds us often that almsgiving, fasting and prayer are the three weapons we have against sin and Satan. These weapons also free us from our self-will which makes self-indulgence the pathway of sin and destructions for ourselves and our world. More importantly these gifts enable us to admit our guilt and make atonement for our sins. Both David and the women in the gospel admitted their guilt and found peace. Simon did not and lived in ignorance of God's unconditional love. Likewise the gift of the Sacrament of Reconciliation is always available to us so that we too can experience, today, the great freedom that comes with re-union with the God of Love. Travel in Peace and Forgiveness.

As Catholic Christians we have an obligation to take care of the most vulnerable among us. The Catholic Charities/Bishop's Annual Appeal is one of the best ways we have of fulfilling Jesus' commandment to "love one another" and "give them something to eat yourselves". It is also the appropriate response to His invitation to give alms, pray and fast in thanksgiving for our deliverance from evil and the gift of eternal life. 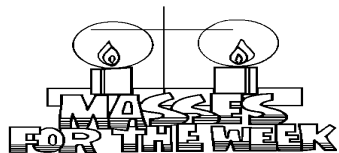
