PASTOR'S CORNER

Perhaps you noticed a nice fresh smell when you entered the church last weekend. The Sainly Sweepers and friends did a wonderful job with some elbow grease and Murphy Oil in cleaning the pews and other parts of the church. My thanks and gratitude in the name of the parish to these wonderful volunteers. The Sainly Sweepers clean the church every Tuesday and are always looking for more volunteers. Both women and men are needed.

My thanks also to those who are contributing in the second collection. As you know the 2nd Sunday of the month is Investment Sunday, last week we collected \$3600. This money is used to pay off the loan to the Diocese and prepare for the building of the new parish center. As was mentioned earlier, we are asking a donation of \$30 a month in either "scrip" revenue (5% back on the scrip you buy which is totally free money) or cash to help reduce the loan. The second collection on the other weeks will be used to buy new carpeting for the church. The carpet is now sixteen years old and some of it is badly stained and torn. Please help to keep our Church looking beautiful and worshipful.

I also remind you of two very important upcoming events. We will celebrate a Healing Mass next Saturday morning at 10:30am. Even if you are not sick please come and support those who are in need of healing. Last week 15000 priests gathered with Pope Benedict in Rome to celebrate the end of the Year of the Priest. We will celebrate our own closing with Mass and refreshments on Wednesday evening at 6:15. Please come and celebrate with us.

We congratulate our new officers of the Pastoral Council: Clare Herm as president, Mary Ann Alulis as vice-president and Jen McDonald as secretary. I am sure that they will do a wonderful job in helping me to lead the parish. My special thanks to Bob and Michele Dooley and Joe and Sharon Trombetta whose terms are up but who will continue as members of the Pastoral Council. The Council meets every 3rd Tuesday and all are welcome to attend.

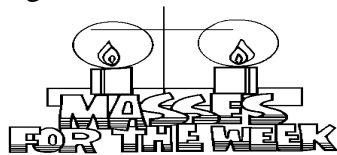
