Social Justice

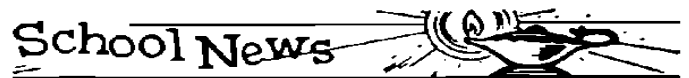

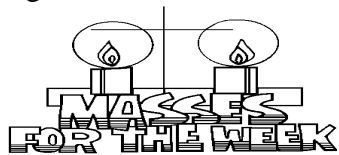
