# PASTOR'S CORNER

The theme of today's readings is deceptively simple – Hospitality!! Jesus says that only one thing is required – being open to spending time with Him.

While we may have the best intentions, casual invitations are too often unrealized. We are busy, and socializing has become yet another activity to be squeezed into our already overscheduled calendars. Of course we are eager to reciprocate with an invitation to those who have hosted us in their homes. But how many of us offer hospitality to complete strangers, as Abraham did? And how many of us see hospitality as a burden, as Martha did? Are we aware that our salvation hinges on hospitality; that is, on our willingness to welcome Jesus into our lives, to sit at His feet and be fed by him, as Mary did?

Hospitality comes from a Greek word *philoxenia* which means love for the guest-stranger and the enjoyment of being a host. Both roles, host and guest, compliment one another. In the ancient world, hospitality was a moral imperative, without which another might die from exposure to the elements or perish from thirst or starvation.

Jesus makes a bold statement that authentic hospitality is subversive because it shatters social boundaries. When we welcome others, especially the lowly, or strangers and “sinners” – to our table, we topple traditional protocols and witness to the love of God that Jesus made incarnate among us. Both guest and host, Jesus also is the meal that nourishes and sustains all people. As we listen to the readings today we are challenged to develop a similarly welcoming attitude toward others. Their example asks us how strangers are welcomed into our neighborhood and faith community.

As always there is also a moral imperative for us today. As authentic Christians we must be hospitable, the question is “how”? To begin with we have a hospitality/welcoming committee that needs members, how about you? Can you give a little time to welcome the strangers among us? Secondly, we are in the midst of our House of Charity Drive. Many have opted not to donate this year. It is interesting to note that all week in the daily scriptures there has been one warning after another about not taking care of the orphans, widows and needy among the chosen people. God says repeatedly that He cannot bless those who do not share their own bounty (however large or small) with those who have less. Do you feel blessed? Are you unsure? How generous are you with the blessings God has granted? Do you see the House of Charity as a burden or a blessing?

**Think about this – your eternal happiness depends on your “yes” to God’s promptings to be generous – NOW!!!!**

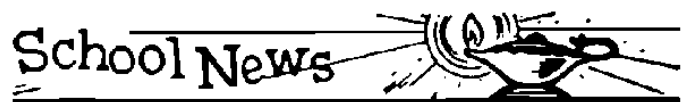

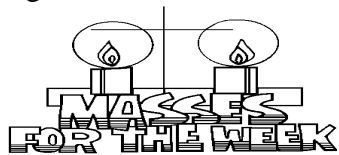
