

We owe God our full-hearted “yes.”

Today’s Scriptures present us with a challenge: to live out our Christian lives wholeheartedly, to love God with everything that is in us, and to put aside our own comfort and ease in the service of our neighbor – especially at the moment we see our neighbor in need.

This is the reality of the call to holiness. I know that if I were to ask you if you were “holy” you would be embarrassed and probably say “no”. This is because we do not understand that “holiness” does not consist in never having erred or sinned. Holiness is a grace (intimacy with the triune God) that increases the capacity for conversion. It is an invitation and a capacity for reconciliation, forgiveness and healing that make us saints. The “way to holiness” is a journey and a destination. It is something that we learn through praying, working, playing and suffering with one another.

This demands the flexibility of the Good Samaritan and the understanding of the Law of Moses that the Law of Love is already written in our hearts. The Samaritan probably had his own plans for the day as he walked along the road. Yet the moment his “heart was stirred” by the robber’s victim he dropped his plans and responded with a full-hearted “yes”. Every day the Holy Spirit will place someone in our path or we in someone else’s. You will be challenged to minister to someone or let someone minister to you. It is the work of the “Body of Christ.”

We will be immersed in the “Way of Holiness” during our Triduum. On July 31st and August 1st and 2nd we will celebrate Masses of Healing for our bodies, minds and spirits. On August 3rd the Diocesan Gospel Choir will sing at the 5pm Mass and then entertain us with a rousing concert at 7pm.

This is your invitation for conversion and renewal, how will you answer? If you are too busy for this you are just too busy!!
